START Pedestrian Area Kössen, **47°40'12.7"N 12°24'20.0"E**

GOAL Landing area Oberbach Kössen, **47°39'10.9"N 12°25'19.1"E**

Equipment: Every participant has to carry his minimum equipment which consists of a paraglider (certified LTF, DHV or. EN), harness with protector, helmet, reserve parachute, GPS tracker and a mobile phone. The equipment has to fulfil the Austrian laws. It is allowed to have a supporter who provides food, clothes, sleeping bag ...

BORDAIRRACE - Task:

The goal is to walk and fly as far as possible away from the start and to make it back to the start within **31 hours**, only by walking or flying. The route is decided by every participant himself. It is no allowed to use any other means of transport.

What's special with the event in Kössen 2017 is the reduced time of 31 hours – the start takes place at 10 o'clock at the main pedestrian area in front of the community centre. (See coordinates above).

BORDAIRRACE – Evaluation:

Minimum distance:

In order to have a valid track your point of return has to be at least 15km (air distance) away from the starting point. 20% of the total distance have to be covered in the air. If your total flying distance is less than 20%, the total distance is reduced so that the 20% rule is fulfilled.

The race committee has the possibility to cancel the 20% rule if this makes sense in terms of safety. If this is the case you will be informed at least at the last briefing.



Distance:

- The total track is the air distance from the starting point to the point of return (point which is furthest away from the start) and to the ending point (position at end of competition);
Total track = track away + track back
- If the flying distance is under 20% (projected on the air distances of the total track) the total track is reduced to 5 x flying distance (means 20% flying + 80% walking)
- If a participant is not back until 5 pm at the second day of the competition, the distance between goal and the final position will be subtracted from the total distance.
Bordairrace distance = total distance – distraction.
- All participants who reach the goal within 31h will receive a 20% bonus.
Bordairrace result = total track + 20% (if in goal before 5 pm)
Latest time for report of the GPS data: 6 pm

Cancelation:

The competition can only be cancelled by the race committee. – If this is the case all participants will be informed by SMS.

Evaluation: The task is documented by GPS. GPS Loggers are provided by the organization. We suggest using a second GPS device for backup reasons. (WGS84 and recording of height is required)
The participant has to make sure that the device is able to record both days completely.
Recording-gaps of 5 minutes or longer are not considered as flight. The point of return has to be recorded!

Interval of recording: at least one point per minute (1 point in 60 sec = 60 points/h x 31 hours = 1860 track-points) Please bring your own cable and device drivers for your backup device!

Safety: In order to be eligible you have to provide a proof of license, insurance and equipment (EN or LTF certified). License and insurance will be checked at registration.

Every participant and supporter has to bring a mobile phone which is always on during the event. **In the evening of the first day every participant has to send his position to the organization between 7pm and 8pm.**

If a participant does not reach the goal before 5pm on the second day, he has to call the retrieve coordinator until 5.30pm. The numbers will be provided at the briefing and can be found on the pilot's card, which will be handed out at registration. If a participant violates flying rules (cloud flying, forbidden airspaces, flying after sunset, ...), he will be disqualified.

Equipment: Every participant has to carry his minimum equipment which consists of a paraglider (certified LTF, DHV or EN), harness with protector, helmet, reserve parachute, GPS tracker and a mobile phone. The equipment has to fulfil the Austrian laws. It is allowed to have a supporter who provides food, clothes, sleeping bag... The glider may only be changed after damage. In that case the organizer has to be informed before a replacement glider is used.



Participation: The number of participants is limited to 50 (in special cases 70). (Order of application; tandems count as one).

Entry fee: € 47,--

The entry fee has to be paid 7 days before the start of the race. Bank details see below.

Categories: solo, ladies and tandem

Protest: The fee for protests is € 50,00. Protests have to be handed in within 30 minutes after the results are published. The jury will decide about the outcome.

Doping: Due to Austrian law it is possible that doping tests are carried out.

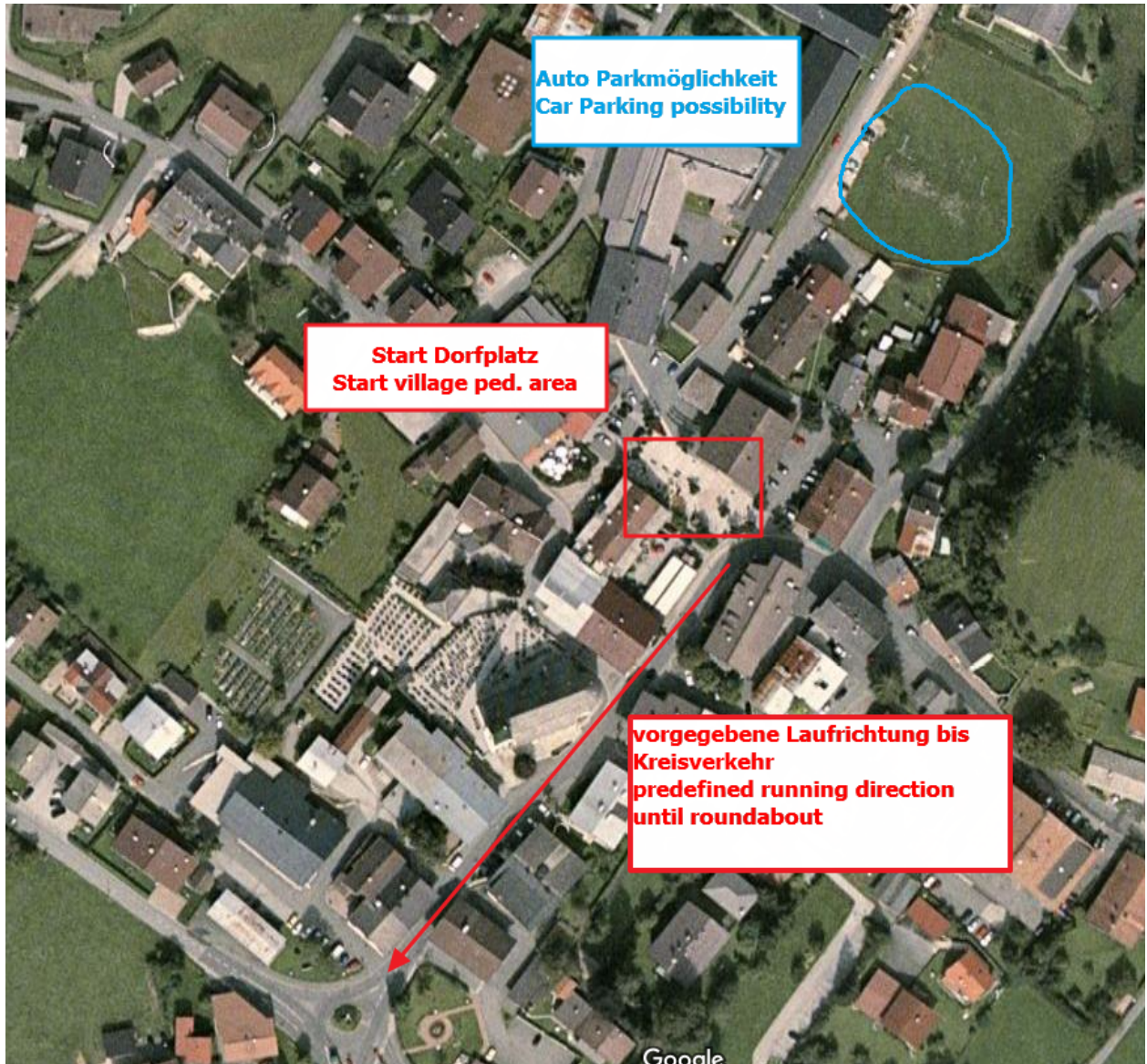

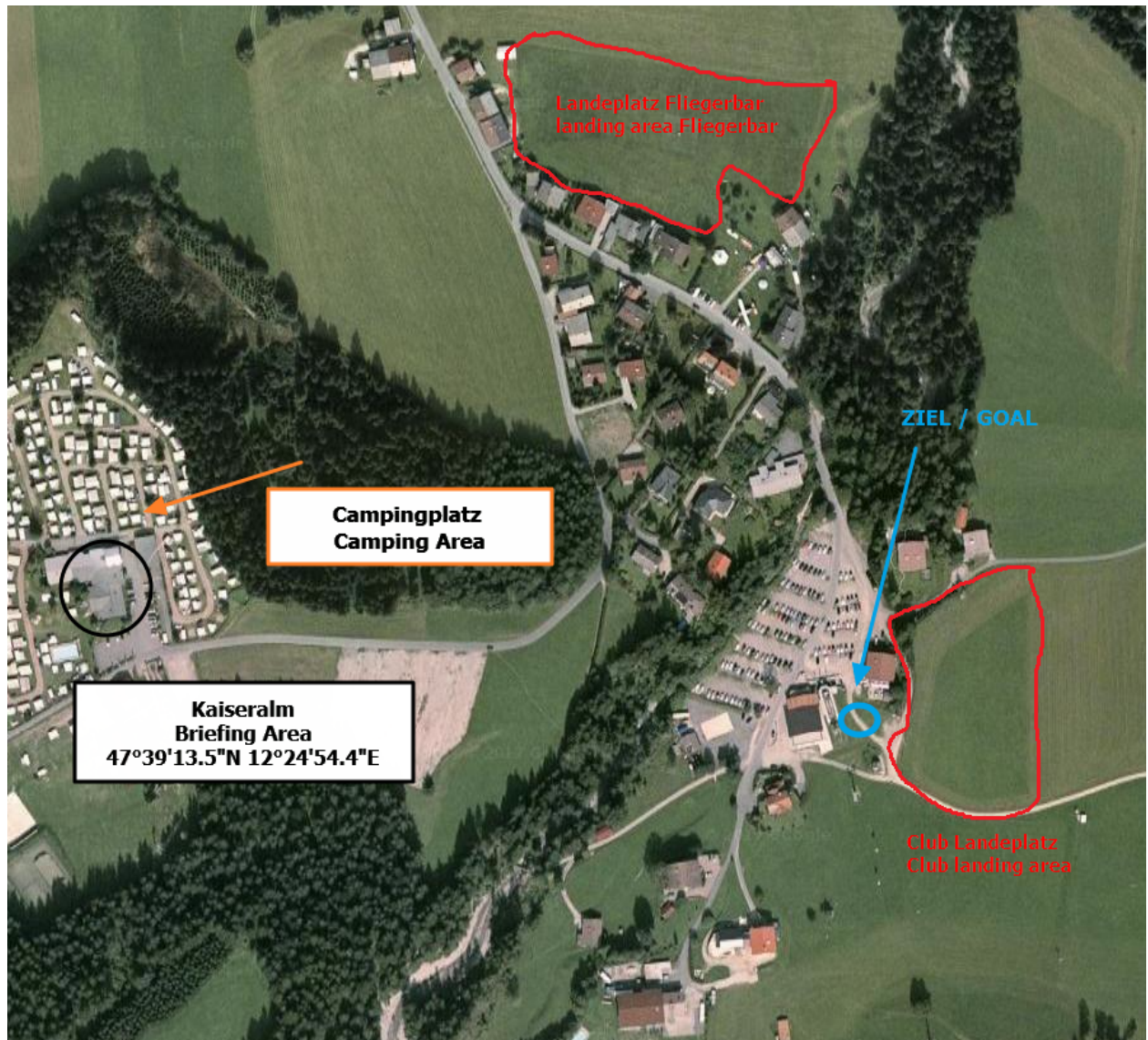
